Your Pathway to Success: Admission & Promotion Requirements

Admission to the RIH Institute is designed to be accessible yet rigorous, ensuring every student has the foundational literacy and numeracy required to succeed. For specialized N4 Engineering and Business programs, a National Senior Certificate (Grade 12) or NCV Level 4 is generally required, while entry into artisan trades like Diesel and Motor Mechanics typically requires an NQF Level 3 or N2 Engineering Certificate.

For experienced individuals who have already spent years in the industry, our Recognition of Prior Learning (ARPL) pathway allows you to fast-track your certification by acknowledging the practical expertise you have already acquired.

Progression through our curriculum relies on a blend of academic mastery and hands-on competence. To advance between N-levels, students must successfully complete four instructional offerings at their current level, eventually qualifying for a National N Diploma (NQF 6) upon completion of the necessary 18 to 24 months of relevant workplace experience.

For those in the School of Occupational Trades, promotion is achieved through the completion of Knowledge, Practical Skill, and Work Experience modules, culminating in the External Integrated Summative Assessment to achieve Red Seal trade status.

FEES

Financial Information: Fees & Payment Terms

Financial planning at the RIH Institute begins with a mandatory, non-refundable registration deposit of R950, which forms part of the overall course fee for all programs.

Depending on the course category, a further deposit is required for the issuance of student cards and registration numbers, ranging from R300 for short skills programmes to R1450 for National Certificates, and R5000 for the full Occupational Health and Safety Officer qualification.

We offer flexible payment terms to ensure our training remains accessible to the local community. Total costs for Engineering Studies are approximately R3900, payable in installments of R750, while Business and Educare certificates total R6150 with monthly payment schedules.

Short Occupational Skills Programmes, such as the First Aid series, have a total cost of R2250, which can be settled via two installments of R500 following the initial registration and deposit.

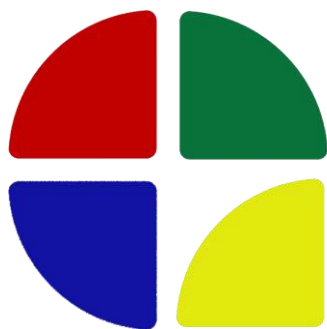
